IRD KEEPS ROLLING IN GEORGIA WITH US\$250,000 CONTRACT

Saskatoon, April 15, 2003 – International Road Dynamics Inc. (IRD) announced today that it has received a contract from Brooks - Berry - Haynie & Associates, Inc. to supply another Automated Truck Weigh Station System in the State of Georgia. The contract is valued at approximately US\$250,000.

The system will be installed this year in Carroll County. IRD has previously supplied ten similar systems at five locations (Catoosa, Monroe, Lowndes, Bryan and McIntosh Counties) in Georgia, signed contracts for three more in Troup and Catoosa Counties, supplied six Truck Rollover Warning Systems at three locations (Fulton, Clayton and DeKalb Counties), and have an ongoing contract for maintenance. These facilities will be integrated with NorPass, a State-operated national commercial vehicle pre-clearance program.

All of the above mentioned Georgia systems utilize IRD's patented Single Load Cell Weigh-In-Motion (WIM) technology. The Automated Truck Weigh Station Systems use the Single Load Cell WIM in combination with Automatic Vehicle Identification (AVI) technology to monitor a truck's weight, credentials, height and other parameters and determine compliance with Georgia regulations. The Truck Rollover Warning Systems monitor a truck's weight, height and speed and provide a warning on an electronic message sign if the truck is in danger of rolling over on an upcoming curve.

Kathleen Gibson, Administrator, Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Oversize Permit Unit, stated, "In these tough economic times we need to be more cost conscious and creative than ever before to ensure the people of Georgia's tax dollars are spent wisely. Since 1997 in Georgia, these systems have a proven record that continues to evolve with our needs to protect the infrastructure and the traveling public while also reducing delays for compliant carriers as truck volume increases, which allows us to focus on the questionable carriers."

Mr. Terry Bergan, President and CEO of IRD noted, "GDOT is committed to a safe, efficient and sustainable transportation system for all users. These IRD systems make the roads safer by allowing enforcement officers to automatically sort through the truck stream to identify the potentially unsafe vehicles. The officers are therefore, able to use their time more efficiently to physically inspect the unsafe vehicles and take corrective action. We are very proud of our continuing relationship with the State of Georgia."
