

Saskatoon, SK JANUARY 5, 2005 – International Road Dynamics Inc. (IRD) announced today the award of a contract for Web-based GPS vehicle tracking and In-Vehicle Driver Management Systems (IVS) from a wholly owned subsidiary of a Calgary-based international oilfield services company. The contract calls for installation of IRD's sophisticated In-Vehicle equipment and a five-year service contract using IRD's web-based software for vehicle tracking, driver compliance reports, vehicle utilization reports, oil field productivity reports, and remote data access for management staff.

The system employs a keypad ID entry option for IRD's driver authentication strategy and blast hazard switch to ensure safe operation in any deployment situation. The system's real-time interaction with vehicle operators enhances this oilfield services company's safety program by reinforcing 'low-force driving' techniques.

IRD will install the system in locations throughout the western United States at 24 locations. Local service and support will be provided by IRD's network of partners and coordinated from IRD's technology center in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

The contract is a five-year service agreement beginning in 2005 with additional option years. The initial contract year has a total maximum value of approximately USD \$318,000 while the remaining years consist of services fees with a total maximum value of approximately USD \$110,853.
